About

Hobart City Mission identified a desperate need in Southern Tasmania for supported accommodation, targeted at single fathers who do not have stable accommodation.

The service gap resulted in children being separated from their fathers, either through the children being placed in Child Safety Services care or the mother being given full-time custody.

Hobart City Mission has developed an innovative program that addresses this gap in services by providing accommodation, support, education and a community setting for single dads. The program is called DIY Dads.

DIY Dads provides 8 self-contained units for males with either full or part time care of their children. The dads can be any age, and are able to stay

at the DIY Dads program for up to two years. Each resident dad is taught skills that can assist them in living independently in the community, such as budgeting, maintaining a tenancy and making healthy lifestyle choices.

As well as accommodation, the program provides life and parent skill training, advocacy and self-guidance to help develop confident and capable single fathers, with the aim of transitioning into independent living in the community.



Benefits

- Increased likelihood of the child remaining in, or returning to their fathers care
- Decreased risk of negative impacts on a child's development, wellbeing and potential
- Independence gained through attaining skills allowing the dads and their kids to live independently in the community
- Development of appropriate and healthy parenting skills
- Demonstration of positive role model behaviours to children and other fathers in the community
- Guidance and education to increase employment potential
- Increased confidence and self-reliance
- Decreased reliance on the welfare services and payments
- A healthy father-child bond is created through fathers having regular and fulfilling relationships with their children
